Program Outcomes

87% of youth who have exited our housing programs have maintained their housing over time, working full-time and/or attending college, and are no longer dependent on social services.

Post services, clients reported an increased sense of competency, an increased belief that they have control over their lives, an increase their resiliency level, and experience a reduction in environmental risk (criminal activity, substance use/abuse, incarceration).

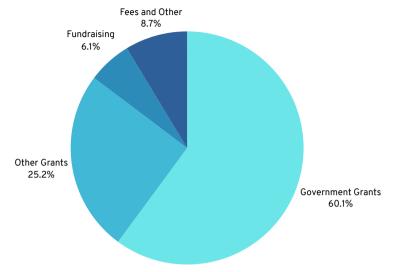
Community Impact

These youth, if not directed to TYFS, would otherwise be supported by county services such as the Juvenile Justice or Child Welfare Systems. Our programs cost a total of \$18,500 per youth served per year as determined by calculating tangible and intangible costs. On average, the total annual per child costs to our community as a result of child maltreatment is \$268,544.

That is a 93% cost savings for our community through TYFS programming.

What this data indicates is that early intervention and prevention services, as those offered by TYFS, provide significant financial relief to the long-term fiscal health of our community.

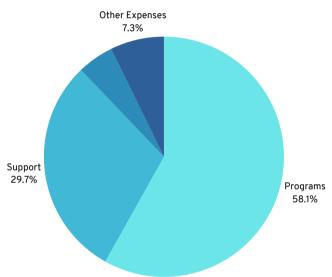
